First Reading (Leviticus 19:1-2,17-18)

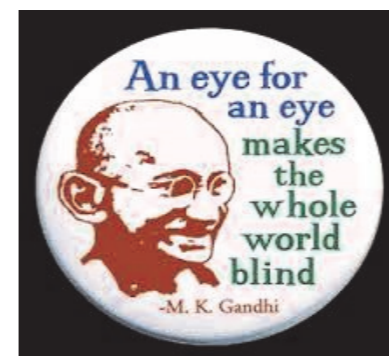
Through Moses, God urges his chosen people to be holy as God is holy. The people must not bear hatred for one another. They must love their neighbour as they love themselves.


Second Reading (1 Corinthians 3:16-23)

St. Paul reminds the fractious Christian community at Corinth that they are God's temple and that the Spirit of God is living among them and their unity as Christians is rooted in Christ. Only in him do we discover our true dignity as children of God; this is also true of others. Sadly, however, too often we allow personalities and human frailty to come between Christ and ourselves.

Gospel Reading (Matthew 5:38-48)

The Gospel is hard if we are to live in the real world. We are expected to accept and endure humiliations and defeats with no reaction. This can mean appearing weak, ineffectual and irrelevant. But maybe when this happens the gospel shines brightest of all.

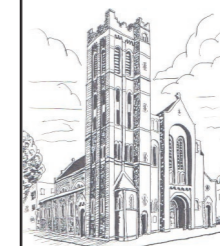
