### First Reading (Ezekiel 18:25-28)

'Ezekiel's teaching centres on inner conversion, a new heart and a new spirit. It is based on being aware of God's mercy and forgiveness, renouncing and repenting one's sins.

### Second Reading (Philippians (2:1-11))

Just as Christ laid down his life for his people, we ought to lay down our lives for others in a spirit of mutual concern and love.

### Gospel Reading (Matthew 21: 28-32)

The conflicts between Jesus and the Jewish religious authorities form the back-drop to the gospels for the next few Sundays, and likely arise from historical events experienced both by Jesus and the early Christian community. The parable of the two sons is about judgement. The two brothers, one promising but not delivering obedience and the other refusing but then offering faithful service, remind us of Cain and Abel and Jacob and Esau, embodying two sharply contrasting ways of life. The second son's 'Certainly, Sir' reminds us of an earlier scene where Jesus teaches that not every who says 'Lord, Lord' will enter the kingdom of God but only he who fulfils the will of the Father (Mt 7:21)

**Fr Christopher Delaney** is celebrating his **Diamond Jubilee** (60 Years) this month and will be coming to St Mary's to celebrate the occasion with



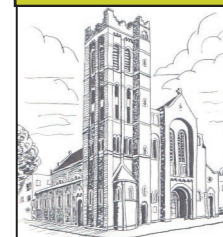
