**First Reading** (2 Kings 4:42-44) Prefiguring clearly today's gospel, the capacity to achieve the miraculous on many occasions - here takes loaves and grain and feeds over 100 men the overflowing generosity of God, Elisha again does the seemingly impossible. - Elisha's life is one of humility, love of his people and utter trust in God - a long life marked by incredibly visible workings of God through him as he sought to serve his people and their rulers.

**Second Reading** (Ephesians 4:1-6) St Paul introduces himself as a prisoner of the Lord, not a title that points to imprisonment as we tend to understand it, but imprisonment in the terms of close proximity, dutiful service and daily growth. One Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God, 'father of all, through all and within all.' In this short passage he counsels how the community needs always to attend to the requirements of unity and charity. It's a message of fraternal concern and counsel, closeness, charity and unity, togetherness with and through Father, Son and Spirit.

**Gospel Reading** (John 6:1-15) The miracle of the loaves and the fishes, the large crowd invited to be seated, the feeding of thousands and enough left over to fill the 12 hampers. The significance of the 12 should not be lost here, a rare moment of harmony in Israel with its 12 tribes and all-too-elusive unity. This earthly food is a pointer to eternal unity and harmony, the Son of Man's true purpose and identity, emerging ever more clearly and to many.

## GIFT AID TO YOUR PARISH

**Gift Aid contributions are a very important part of our parish income.**

If you wish to Gift Aid please contact a member of the Finance Committee:- John Roblin, Doreen Utley or Phil Dooley. They will gladly help you to complete the mandate which will enable you to start your Gift Aid contribution. Alternatively you can speak to one of the priests.

### Who can Gift Aid?

**Two conditions are required:**

(1) **You must be (UK) tax payer.**

(2) **The Gift Aid Offering must be recorded in one of two ways.**

(i) **banker's order**, the majority of people contribute in this way

(ii) **numbered envelope.**

(2) This means that the parish can claim back an additional 25% of your contributions, at no additional cost to yourself.


