### GIFT AID TO YOUR PARISH

**Gift Aid contributions are a very important part of our parish income.** If you wish to Gift Aid please contact John Roblin, Doreen Utley or Phil Dooley. They will gladly help you to complete the mandate which will enable you to start your Gift Aid contribution. Or you can speak to one of the priests.

**Who can Gift Aid? There 2 conditions:**

- (1) **You must be (UK) tax payer.**
- (2) **The Gift Aid Offering must be recorded in one of two ways.**
  - (i) **banker's order**, the majority of people contribute in this way
  - (ii) **numbered envelope**

This means that the parish can claim back an additional 25% of your contributions, at no additional cost to yourself.



**First Reading** (*Wisdom 7:7-11*) Here, wisdom is presented as a woman to be prized and valued. Wisdom is, of course, also one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The gift of wisdom should be prized even more than silver and gold and precious gems. It is a gift. And a gift is something which comes from God. A gift which we can ask for, request, pray for.

**Second Reading** (*Hebrews 4:12-13*) This excerpt from the book of Hebrews reminds us that the Word of God is ever alive and active. We can never know where the word of God will touch someone's life, bringing comfort, illumination, healing and challenge. The word is to be heard, but it is also to be absorbed into our hearts where the Spirit of God speaks to our lives.

**Gospel Reading** (*Mark 10:17-30*) This part of Mark's gospel continues to present the challenges which the message of Jesus brings. Wealth and riches are one of the great dangers to following Jesus. A follower of Jesus is willing to be dependent. Riches, on the other hand, foster independence. With enough riches, we can begin to imagine that we are God, rather than relying on the goodness and generosity of God.


